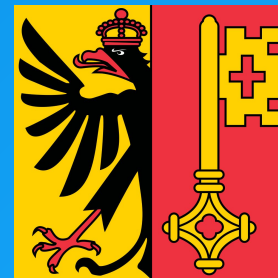

Ecosystem Density and Sector Diversity

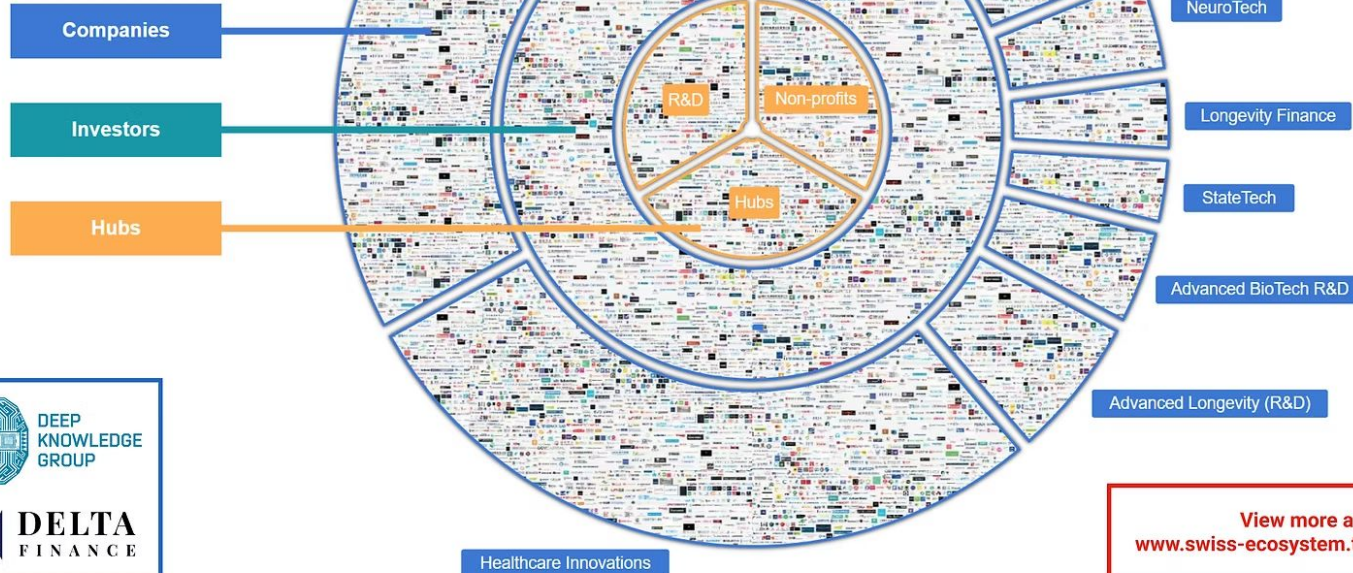

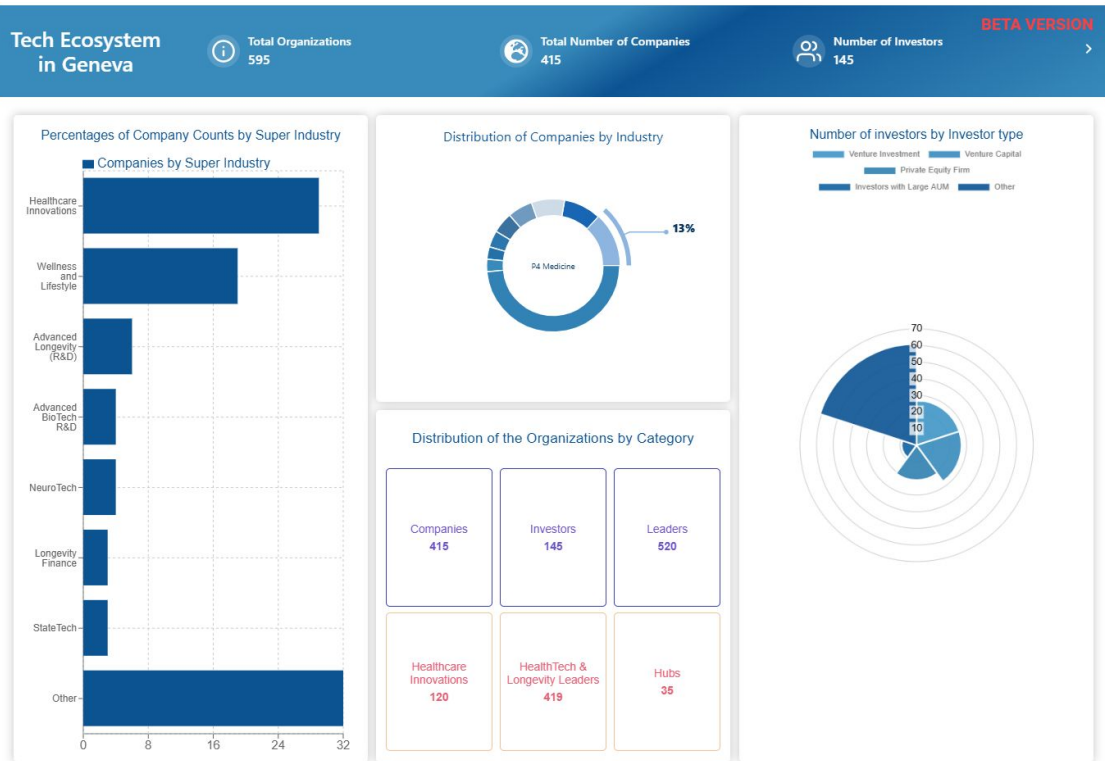

History, Current State and The Road Ahead

History

Geneva's transformation into a tech hub began in the early 2000s with the establishment of the University of Geneva's technology incubators and innovation centers. Over the last decade, a focus on AI, biotech, and Longevity sectors led to collaborations with international research institutions and investment firms. The region's strategic positioning in global diplomacy, alongside robust financial systems, has gradually shifted the city's identity toward high-tech innovation, drawing in major players like EPFL and Biopôle Lausanne, which accelerated growth in specialized DeepTech areas.

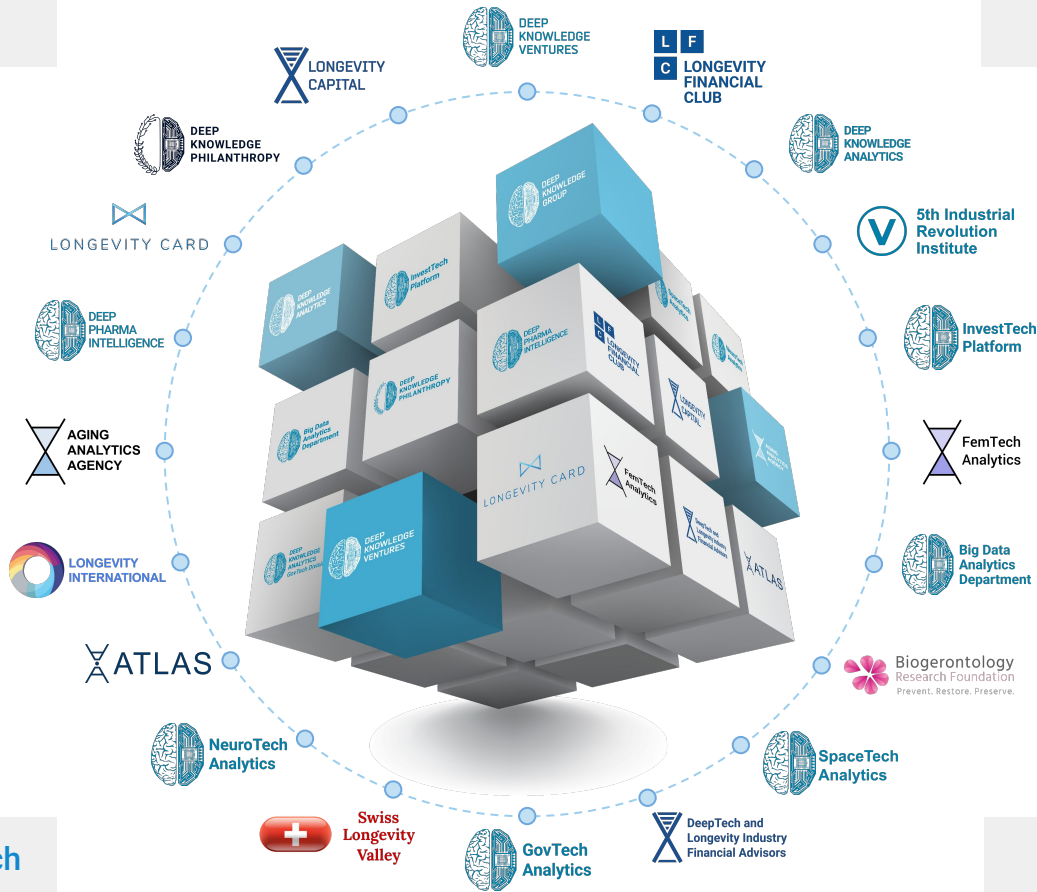
